Next year will see the introduction of new students officers at Riseholme, Hull and Holbeach, which will give students at these campuses a voice! I will support these roles to ensure their effective and working for all students.

**BETTER COMMUNICATION**

The Union needs to develop a better way of communicating with students. My approach would see officers working alongside student media, not against it, making sure you know what's going on in your Union and University, and how to get involved. Put simply - working with students, for students.
